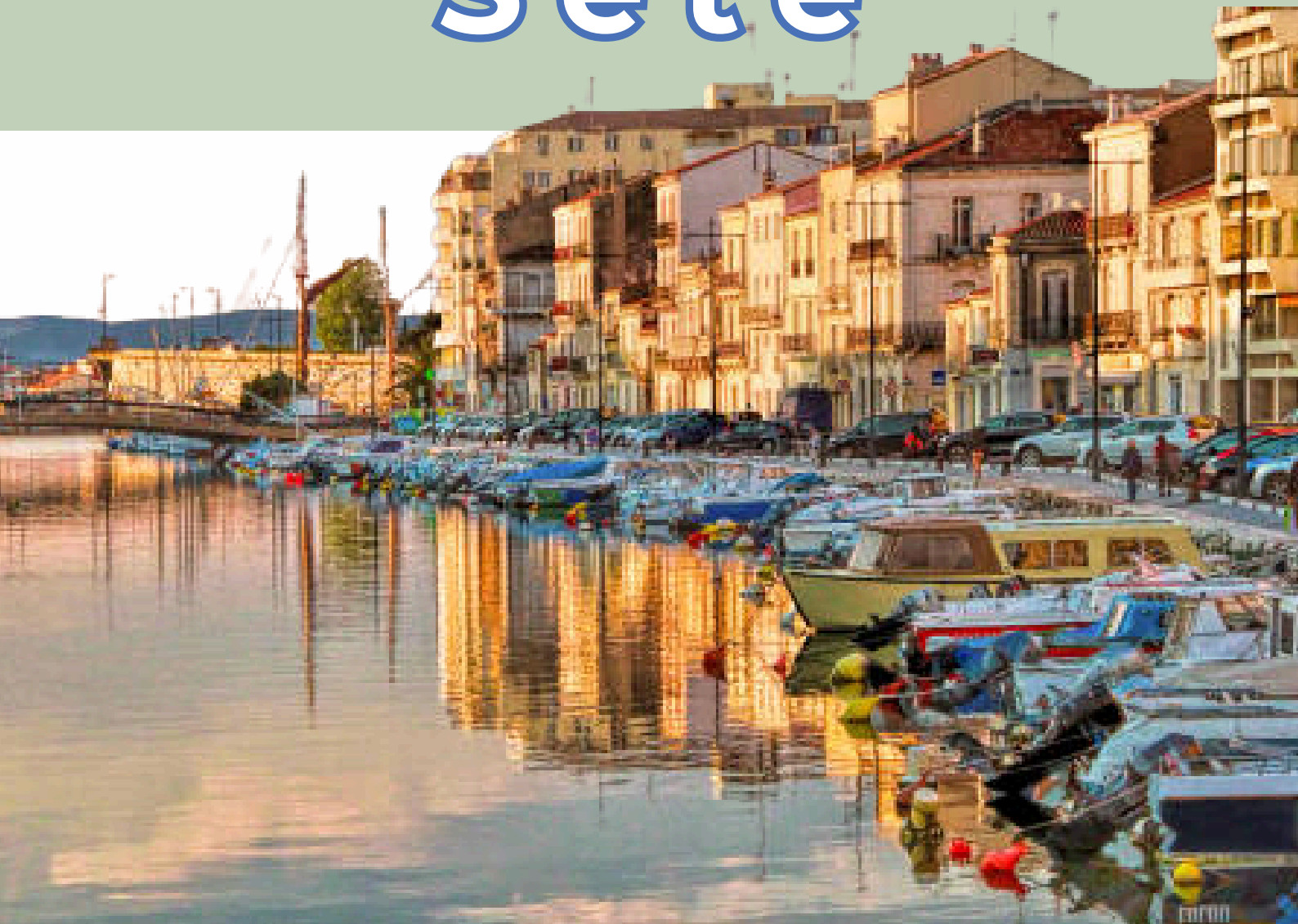

Official taxis are available in front of the arrivals hall - Association des Taxis Aéroport de Montpellier

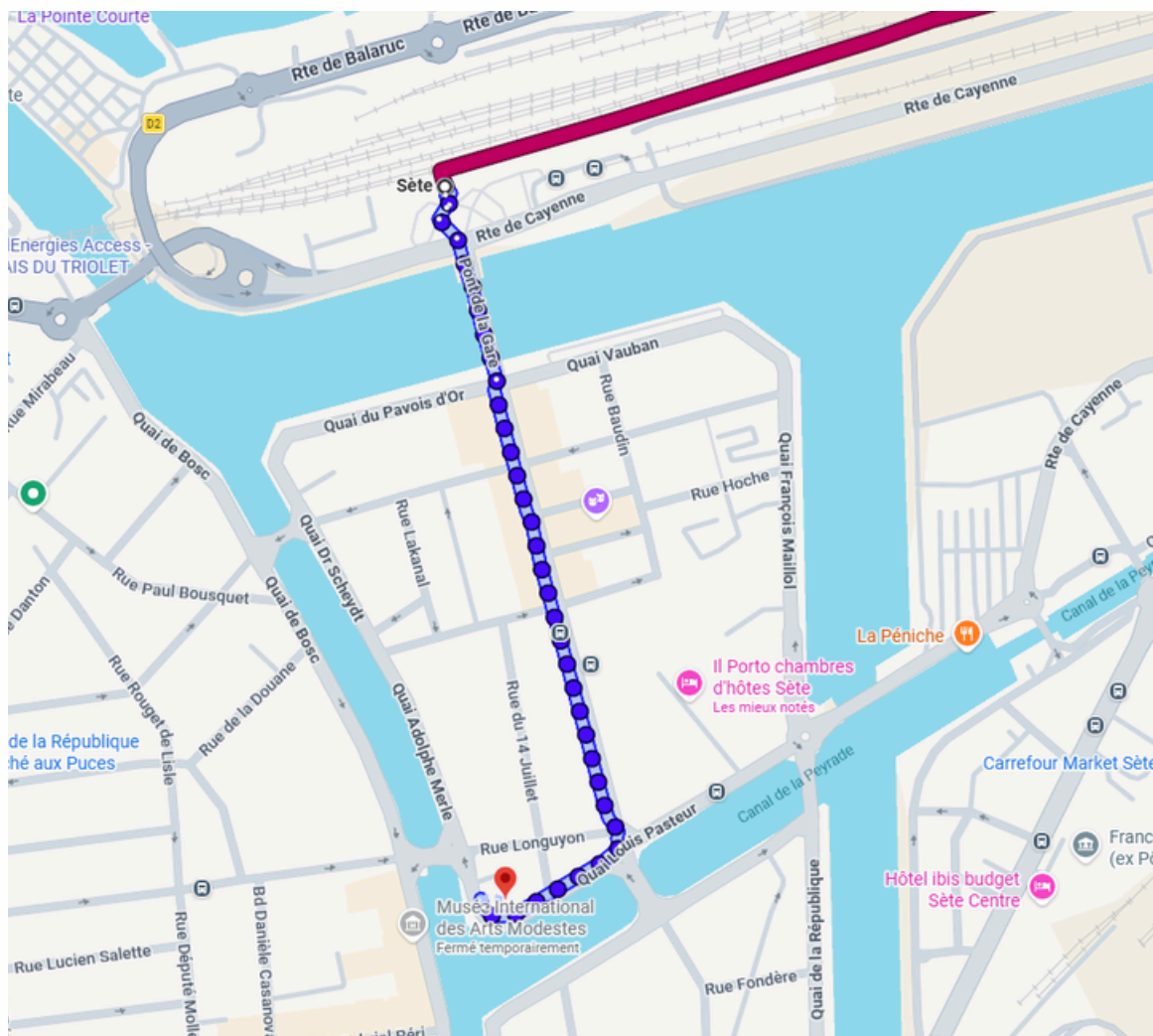


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From Sète train station to the Maison Régionale de la Mer, Sète

ELECTRICITY

Power plug types C and E are used in France.

- Standard voltage: 220–240 V
- Frequency: 50 Hz
- Participants travelling from outside continental Europe may require a power adapter.

PAYMENT

Most shops, restaurants and taxis accept card payments, including major international debit and credit cards. However, some smaller establishments may require cash payment. ATMs are widely available throughout the city. Contactless payment is commonly used.

- **ETIAS authorisation**: Depending on nationality, travellers may be required to apply for an ETIAS travel authorisation. The application is completed online via a standard electronic form.
